




### POPULATION AND SHORT-TERM PROJECTIONS

### Washington County Population and Projected


Population, 2010-2028

By 2060, the population is projected to be nearly 500,000



Age disparity between the County and the state is expected to increase in the coming four years




#### Historic and Projected Median Age, 2010-2028


Slightly more than half of the migrants to Washington County are coming from outside Utah

Hispanic or Latino Population, 2010-2022











Single mothers with young children are most impacted by poverty




#### Families in Poverty, Washington County, 2022






















